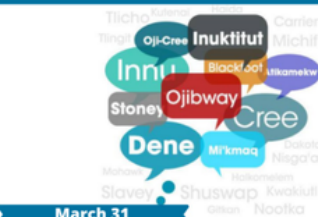

Graduating Students planning to attend College or University are encouraged to book tours of potential schools through their individual websites.

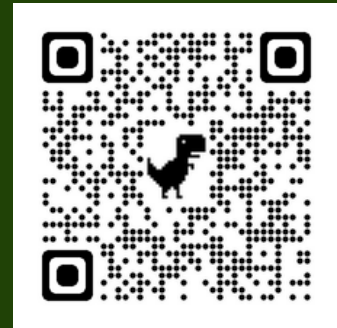
**Course Selection is almost complete!**

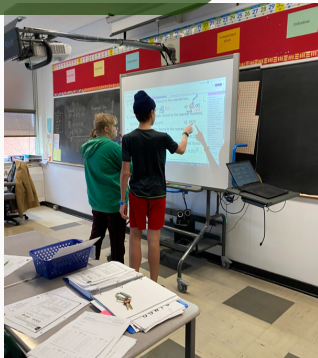
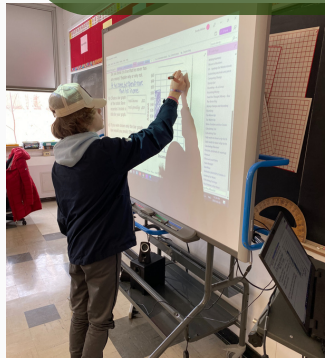






# A view from the classroom:
